Project Title: City of Anna Maria - Multi-Use Path Expansion.

- Please confirm if the road it is being worked on is a local or a state road.

This sidewalk/multi use path is not a road. However, all roads within the City of Anna Maria are owned and maintained by the City of Anna Maria. There are no State roadways in the city.

- Has the MPO or DOT Regional Division reviewed or been contacted about this work?

As this is a city owned sidewalk/multiuse path neither agency has been contacted

- Does this help with parking issues that have happened in the city?

The expansion of this sidewalk/multiuse path has a neutral impact on parking.

“Issues” associated with parking in Anna Maria were generated when public parking spaces in close proximity to the beach were eliminated in Holmes Beach during COVID. The reduced public parking in close proximity to the beach caused beach goers to then come north to the City of Anna Maria to find parking close to the beach.
