Before me, a JUDGE of the CIRCUIT COURT, in and for Manatee County, Florida,
DETECTIVE Josiah Hartsell, a duly sworn officer of the
MANATEE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, personally or by sworn attestation says that on or about
the 11th of February, 2022 in the aforesaid county, one
CASH JOHN NICHOLS, did unlawfully:

On 02/11/2022 at approximately 2224 hours, the driver of Manatee County Transit trolley 63861 stopped at the bus stop of 100 S. Bay Blvd., within Manatee County. Trolley camera footage showed a white male with a beard and no shoes approach the doors in order to ride the trolley home. The driver denied the male access due to him not having any shoes on. The male became argumentative towards the driver, at which point the driver closed the trolley doors. The male then began hitting the glass on the doors with his fists causing it to crack. After causing the damage, the male walked away. The damage was estimated at \$500.

The male was identified by Dep. P. Manning as the defendant, Cash Nichols. Additionally, on the same date at approximately 2351 hours, Dep. Penberthy made contact with the defendant, Cash Nichols, at the post office (101B S Bay Blvd) directly across the street from the incident location. Prior to making contact, a passerby informed Dep. Penberthy that they had spoken to the defendant, and that the defendant stated he was denied bus access due to not having any shoes on. The defendant requested a ride, and was ultimately transported by Dep. Penberthy.

Based on the circumstances, probable cause exists to charge the defendant with criminal mischief greater than \$200 less than \$1,000.


- Because Defendant is required to register as a sexual offender under s.943.0435, he/she is not eligible for release on bail or surety bond until first appearance. His/her bond amount should therefore be listed as "to be set at first appearance." See Section 903.046(2)(m), Fla.Stat.
- Because Defendant is required to register as a sexual predator under s.775.21, he/she is not eligible for release on bail or surety bond until first appearance. His/her bond amount should therefore be listed as "to be set at first appearance." See Section 903.046(2)(m), Fla.Stat.
